

SHOW TIMES

Thursday, May 31, Set Up 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. Friday, June 1, 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Saturday, June 2, 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Doors open for exhibitors at 8:30 a.m. Friday and 9:30 a.m. Saturday. This is a two-day show. Exhibitors must be ready at 9:30 a.m. and remain open during all show hours and until 5:00 p.m. Saturday. Check-In at EOWA table for booth assignment and packet. Tables will be in place Thursday. Building is locked overnight. Tables must be covered on top and all 4 sides to the floor (sheets not permitted).

FEES

Entry Fee: \$45.00 per 10'x10' space No refunds after May 28, 2018. Rental Tables: \$15 each 8'x30"x30." **EXHIBITORS NEED TO BRING THEIR OWN CHAIRS.** Pegboards are not provided. COMMERCIAL SPACES: first-come-first serve.

APPLICATIONS

This is a woodcarving and folk art festival. All exhibited items must be hand-crafted by the exhibitor. Registrations should be received no later than May 26, 2018. Late registration will be accepted based on cancellations. Exhibitors must sign Agreement on Application Form. Exhibitors under 18 years of age must have an adult (21 years or older) sponsor in the booth.

First-time Show applicants are required to submit pictures representative of their work with their application. The Show Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any application and/or display and is the final authority on all show policies.



SEMINARS AND DEMONSTRATIONS

EOWA will present a beginners seminar on woodcarving Friday and Saturday carving a project from wood (adults) or high-density foam (youth) for ages 12 and up. Other seminars are in the planning stages. Times will be posted. Exhibitors are encouraged to demonstrate their craft in their booth where possible.

WOODCARVING COMPETITION

Open Category Judging begins at 10:00 a.m. on Friday; Novice Category immediately follows the Open judging. Judging is by teams that are trained and assigned by the EOWA. Open competition is only for exhibitors present at the show. Awards will be presented immediately following judging.

A.B. SMITH MEMORIAL CARVING CONTEST.

A carving contest, open to all exhibitors and EOWA members assisting in show functions, will be held on Saturday, from 11 a.m. to 12:15. Contestants are limited to one knife (tool), one pencil, and one sharpening device. A blank, the subject of which remains secret until contest time, is furnished at no charge. Judging and Awards will be made at the close of the contest.

SALES

Sales are permitted. THE EOWA TAKES NO COMMISSION ON SALES. Sales tax is the responsibility of exhibitors. If you do not possess an Oklahoma tax permit, you will be required to submit a tax report to the Oklahoma Tax Commission. EOWA will provide the form and instructions in your exhibitor packet.

No smoking or firearms are allowed on the Broken Arrow Central Park Community Center campus. For the safety and comfort of all the only animals allowed are certified service dogs.

WOODCARVING JUDGING CATEGORIES

Each exhibitor is limited to one (1) entry per category. Additional credit may be given for originality. **Any item winning a BLUE ribbon in any previous EOWA Show is not eligible.** Category must have a minimum of two pieces entered to be judged. Single items from un-judged categories will be placed in the MISCELLANEOUS category. **The Miscellaneous Category is only for un-judged category items**. All decisions by the judging committee are final.

WOODCARVING CATEGORIES

- 1. All Relief, Low and High natural or painted
- 2. Chip Carving, flat, three-dimensional, gouge any subject, any finish.
- 3. Carousel & Mythical Figures: Single or group any finish.
- **4. Carved Walking Stick & Canes**: Any type of walking stick and cane will be in this category, any finish.
- 5. Carved Footwear: any type, any finish.
- 6. Realistic Human single, any finish
- 7. .
- 7. Marine Life any finish.
- **8. Waterfowl** (shore birds, wading birds, swimming birds) single, any finish.
- 9. Songbirds and Birds of Prey single, any finish.
- 10. Animal single, any finish.
- 11. Group Mixed Subject two or more species, any finish.
- 12. Stylized any subject, natural finish, grain must show.
- 13. Caricature Human single figure, any finish.
- 14. Caricature Wildlife single species, any finish.
- 15. Caricature Group Same Subject -any finish.
- 16. Caricature Group Mixed Subject any finish.
- 17. Unusual Woods (includes cypress knees, cottonwood bark and driftwood) -any subject, any finish.
- **18. Miniature** must not exceed 2" x 2" x 2", any finish.
- 19. Religious any finish (may represent any religious philosophy).
- **20**. **Holiday** any finish (secular holidays such as Valentine's, Halloween, Thanksgiving, Christmas/Santa Claus, etc.)
- 21. Pyrography Non-carved item, any subject, any finish.

- **22.** Instructor assisted/Seminar Carving carvings created with extensive help from an instructor (i.e. using an instructor's blank, and/or carving on the piece by the instructor).
- **23**. **Decorative Functional** any subject, any finish with a specific function or use carved in (love spoons, bottle stoppers, etc.).
- 24. Floral any finish.
- **25. Miscellaneous** 1 Carvings from <u>un-judged categories</u> (categories only one entry).
- **26**. **Miscellaneous** 2 Carvings that do not fit any category.
- **27. Novice** entrant has never won more than 3 blue ribbons in the Novice Category or 1 blue in an EOWA Open Competition. EOWA novice club members participating in show are eligible to enter.
- 28. Gourds Wood-burned, carved, any style, any finish.

WOODTURNING

- **29**. **Spindle Turnings** lamp base, candlesticks, turned between centers, turned furniture parts, letter openers, pens and pencils, lace bobbins, mallets, etc.
- 30. Turned vessels- face plate or chuck turned items
- **31. Woodturnings w/Fancy Decorations** any woodturning with fancy decoration, such as carving, inlay, intarsia, coloration, segmentation, lacing, piercing, attached cords, feathers, glass beads, etc.
- **32. Any Other Turned Object** any turned piece that cannot be reasonably placed within one of the preceding categories.

SCROLL SAW

- **33.** Intarsia pictures made by cutting and shaping different kinds of wood.
- 34. Fretwork
- 35. Scroll
- **36**. **Three-Dimensional Items** items cut and assembled to provide a decorative piece, but does not have a function other than decoration.
