## **NEXT MEETING: Wednesday, JUNE 8, 7:00PM.**

The May meeting will be at the St. Stephens Methodist Church, 400 W. New Orleans, in Broken Arrow. The presentation will be by Rusty Johnson titled "The Good, The Bad and the Ugly or I Don't Know Much About Carving But I Know What I like", previously known as Judges Refresher Training. It will be a discussion on criticism as it pertains to the art of woodcarving. There will be a slide presentation and (hopefully) a robust discussion of how we quantify our judging competition.

This carving by Calvin Berry is an example of a stylized falcon. If you were judging it in a carving competition what would you see as its strong points and its weak points.

On a scale of 1 (low) - 25 (high) how many points would you award for carving ability?

On a scale of 1 (low) - 15 (high) how many points would you award for artistry?

On a scale of 1 (low) - 10 (high) how many points would you award for finish?

Maximum points possible 50.

A total score of between 41 and 50 awards it a Blue ribbon.

Between 31 and 40 is red ribbon award.

Between 21 and 30 is white ribbon.

Anything below is honorable mention.

We will discuss it and more at the June meeting.
