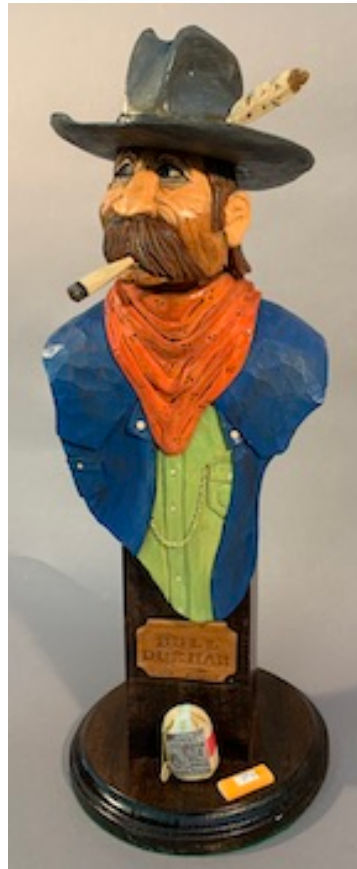




NEXT MEETING: Wednesday, September 13, 7:00PM.
