

### NEXT MEETING: Wednesday, January 8, 7:00PM.



As usual the meeting will be at the St. Stephens Methodist Church in Broken Arrow.






The red dots in the right eye illustration below are in the same plane and the same depth as the left eye.

#### **CARVING THE HUMAN EYE**



Basic steps (from top to bottom):

trim one edge to round off one edge of block



Use a gouge or knife (gouge is easier) to define a mound on the diagonal that will become the eye, leaving plenty of room for the lids.




Shape upper and lower lids, round off the eye ball, lids are not straight lines unless squinting.



Don't be afraid to deepen the inner canthus and opposite side. Add detail of pupil, iris and lids.



Voila!



The lower lid is slightly recessed compared to the upper lid

Alternatives to realistic detail, (top to bottom): Googly eyes, squinty eyes, one eye, caricature big eyes.


#### 2025 EOWA Folk Art and Woodcarving Show:
