



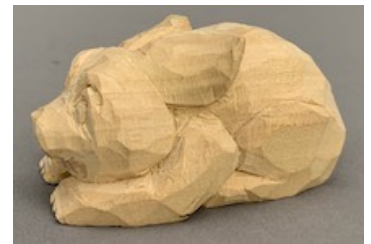

Wood-burning Tips You Should Know

- Don't breath fumes from your burning.
- Use a fan to draw off smoke. Blowing across your project will cool your burning tip.
- Clean carbon buildup from tips. Sand lightly to clean tip.
- Use low temperature settings. You can always darken but it is a lot harder to lighten.
- Pyrography is not a race. It takes time.
- Smooth wood makes for better burning.
- Clean up goofs with a sharp knife or sandpaper to carefully remove charred wood.
